Danbury Symphony Orchestra Annual Student Concerto Competition 2025 Guidelines

- The competition is open to instrumentalists no older than high school seniors.
- Contestants must reside in Connecticut, New York, or New Jersey.
- Finalists will perform for a panel of judges, including Ariel Rudiakov, Music Director & Conductor Danbury Symphony Orchestra.
- Finalists should perform one movement only of a standard orchestral concerto (approximately 10-15 minutes long)
- Contestants must provide their own accompanists.
- First-place winners from previous years are not eligible to participate.
- Second and Third-place winners from previous years are eligible to participate.
- The winner must be available to solo with the Danbury Symphony Orchestra at their Young People's Concert, performing one movement of a concerto with the orchestra, on April 27, 2025, at 3 pm in Danbury. CT.

Prizes to further music studies will be awarded as follows:

First Place-\$500 and solo with Danbury Symphony Orchestra

Second Place-\$300

Third Place-\$200

The recital of finalists will be held at the Marian Anderson Recital Hall at the Danbury Music Centre on Sunday, March 30, 2025, at 3 pm. The winner will be announced after the recital.

Rehearsal time in the Marian Anderson Recital Hall may be booked by emailing dmc@danburymusiccentre.org. The hall is available most afternoons prior to the recital of finalists. We may also be able to book 15-minute rehearsals before the recital.

There are two pianos available for use, a Mason Hamlin grand and a Steinway B.

Guests of the finalists are welcome to attend.
